

This rubric can help students better understand your expectations:

Stack planning and navigation.	Buttons don't link. One or no buttons. Dead-end cards.	Title card, four content cards, bibliography.  Two or more buttons per card.  Two cards with sounds, animations, or other features.  User moves easily from card to card in a sequence.	Satisfactory work, plus:  Additional cards.  Four cards with sound, animation, or other features.  Uses button or hypertext to link to additional content, then returns to main sequence.	Good work, plus:  Includes a hyperlink to an Internet source.  Uses hypertext to link to additional content.
Stack design, use of features.	No transitions, sounds, or animations.  Stack is not organized, extra cards, or cards not linked.	Buttons are placed in same area. Icons or text show function at a glance.  Features don't detract from meaning.  Uses transitions, sound effects, and clip art.	Background color and art is consistent throughout stack, adding unity.  Features used add additional meaning, such as sound effects related to content.  Uses graphics from other sources.	Graphics from two or more outside sources.
